Bird Feeder and Housing Policy

Riverwalk Tucson Homeowners Association Governing Documents empower the Board of Directors to write policy for the community. Accordingly, this Bird Feeder and Housing Policy will be in effect as of March 1, 2021.

Pigeons continue to be a problem for many Tucson communities due to over-population and rapid reproduction. Hundreds of pigeons live within or on the boundaries of Riverwalk Tucson. These vermin are attracted particularly to sources of food and shade.

Resulting pigeon droppings on roof tops and edges, as well as other areas that provide space to rest and roost, can cause damage. Acids produced by this waste can eat through some roof material and may result in leaks. Additionally, pigeon droppings are known to spread disease among both pets and humans.

Riverwalk Tucson has implemented proactive pest management, including an on-going abatement program. Yet, mitigating this community-wide problem is the responsibility of every Lot owner.
